Appellant respectfully requests that this case be reinstated for the purpose of filing a Writ of Certiorari in the South Carolina Supreme Court. Appellant is an inmate of the South Carolina Department of Corrections and as such must function under the rules and regulations of the SCDC and the Institution which he is housed at. Appellant was unable to meet the 30 day deadline to file for a Writ of Certiorari due to certain impediments and encumbrances with regard to scheduling time in the Law Library, making copies of documents related to the record and producing copies of any documents which originated from Appellant (the SCDC by rule will not photo copy these). When it became apparent to Appellant that he would not meet the time deadline he filed on September 25, 2017 a Motion for Extension of Time. On October 5, 2017 Appellant signed for and received from the Tyger River Mailroom a letter from the Clerk of Court dated September 29, 2017 which stated that the Court no longer had jurisdiction over this matter and no action would be taken with regard to the Motion for Extension of Time.

It is Appellant's strong belief that his Constitutional Rights have been seriously abridged in this matter and he pleads upon the Court's mercy that he be allowed to continue to seek a just resolution of the issues in this case.


