RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rule 208(a)(1), the Brief of appellant is due within thirty (30) days of receipt of transcript. According to the Record on Appeal, the transcript was received by the appellant on June 29, 2017. Thirty (30) days thereafter would be July 29, 2017. On July 26, 2017, appellant requested an extension of time in order to file his Initial Brief. Pursuant to this Court's Order dated July 31, 2017, the appellant was granted until August 30, 2017 to file his Initial Brief.


As of this date, Respondent had not received appellant's Initial Brief. A call to the Appellate Court Case Manager, Jessica, revealed that the Initial Brief had, in fact, been filed on August 21, 2017 and received by this Court on August 23, 2017. Although



appellant certified that a copy of said Initial Brief was provide to respondent, one was, in fact, not received. Respondent, accordingly, downloaded a copy of the Initial Brief from this Court's C-Track website. Pursuant to Rule 208(a)(2), respondent should have thirty (30) days within which to serve her Brief. 
