ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter after conducting a review pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967).¹ Petitioner has now filed a motion seeking an extension to file a petition for a writ of certiorari with this Court.

In *State v. Lyles*, 381 S.C. 442, 673 S.E.2d 811 (2009), this Court held that it "will no longer entertain petitions for writs of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has dismissed an appeal after conducting an *Anders* review." Accordingly, the motion for an extension is denied.
