FOR THE FIRST STAGE OF A BURGLARY
INVESTIGATION (NONE OF MY PRINTS
ANYWHERE) OUTSIDE OR INSIDE OF
THIS HOUSE THAT THE OWNER HAD
DIED 6^{MONTHS} PRIOR THAT NOBODY LIVES IN
TO THIS PRESENT DAY.... BURS 1ST ?
THE STATE CANNOT PLACE ME INSIDE
OF THIS HOUSE AT ANY GIVEN
TIME.

4TH PROBLEM THE ONLY OFFICER
