

ORDER

On September 30, 2016, this court dismissed this appeal, holding that this court lacks jurisdiction to review an order of the single commissioner. Appellant has filed a motion, which we construe as a motion to reinstate the appeal, explaining that he filed an appeal with the Workers' Compensation Commission, but the Commission denied his request to waive filing fees and dismissed his appeal. Appellant attached a memorandum from the Commission, which states that the Chair of the Commission rejected Appellant's request to waive the filing fees.

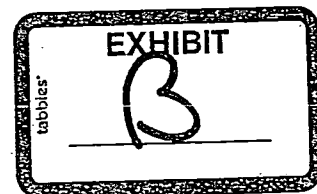
Because the Appellant appealed the single commissioner's order to the Commission and the Commission dismissed his appeal after Appellant's request to waive fees was denied, we reinstate this appeal. The scope of this appeal is limited to issues stemming from the denial of Appellant's request to waive fees and the dismissal of his appeal to the Commission. This court will not consider any issues stemming from the single commissioner's order.

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On September 30, 2016, this Court dismissed this appeal, finding the Court lacked jurisdiction to review an order of the single commissioner of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission. Appellant then filed a motion, which this Court construed as a motion to reinstate the appeal, in which Appellant argued he tried to file an appeal with the Commission, but the Commission denied his request to waive the filing fee and ultimately dismissed his appeal.

On December 1, 2016, Judge Lockemy issued an order reinstating the appeal and ordered the parties to address only the issue of whether the Commission erred by denying Appellant's request to waive the filing fees and dismissing his appeal. (Dec. 1, 2016 Order, attached as **Exhibit A**). Appellant filed a voluminous initial brief addressing this issue and many others.

After receiving the December 1 order and reviewing this issue, Respondents believe Appellant timely filed his Form 30 to appeal to the Appellate Panel. Pursuant to South Carolina Regulation 67-205, documents delivered to the Commission are generally considered filed on the date they are received by the Commission's office. See 23 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 67-205(B) (1976). However, several forms, including the Form 30, are deemed filed on the date of the accompanying certificate of service properly addressed to the Commission. 23 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 67-205(D) (1976).


Here, the single commissioner served a copy of its order on February 24, 2016. (Single Commission Order, p. 20, attached as **Exhibit B**). Appellant had fourteen days to request Commission review of the single commissioner order by filing a Form 30. See 23 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 67-701(A). In other words, Appellant had to file the Form 30 by March 9. Appellant's handwritten certificate of service accompanying his Form 30 is dated March 8. (Form 30, attached as **Exhibit C**). It appears the Commission likely committed a clerical error by dating the Form 30 as March 11, which was the date of receipt by the Commission. The Commission should have accepted Appellant's Form 30 as filed on March 8 according to the certificate of service.

Because Appellant's Form 30 was timely, the Commission should have granted his Form 32, which was his request to waive the filing fees associated with the appeal. The parties would waste considerable time and expense by briefing this issue when the case should likely be remanded to the Workers' Compensation Commission to allow the Commission to accept Appellant's Form 30. Although this Court has instructed the parties to brief this issue, Respondents write to the Court to respectfully request instructions on how to proceed with this appeal in order to dispense with it efficiently. If the Court issues an order advising the parties to brief this issue, Respondents respectfully requests an additional thirty days from the date of any order to file its initial brief.



STATEMENT OF ISSUE ON APPEAL

- (1). Whether there were a clerical error, prohibiting/causing the Chair Person to reject form 32 to waive the filing fee's. For the appellant to appeal to the full commission where clerk clocked-in form 30 the date the commission recieved it, rather than date is was mailed, with accompanying certificate of service dated March 8, 2016.
- (2). Did the Chair Person Err denying McCall's form 32 or rejecting form 32 to waive filing fee's. where certificate of service dated March 8, 2016 accompaned the form 30. But the clerks office erred clocking the form 30 in March 11, 2016 instead of March 8, 2016 date is was mailed.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Terry McCall, Appellant filed his workers compensation claim on form 50 by mailing his form 50 on November 18, 2014, the commission recieved the form 50 for injuries suffered on June 30, July 4, 2014 on November 20, 2014, requesting a hearing.

A hearing was set for August 28, 2015 in front of Commissioner, Gene McCaskill. In which benifits for total temporary benifits and medical benifits were denied. The Order of denial was mailed to Appellant on February 24, 2016.

On March 8, 2016 Appellant mailed out his form 30 requesting commission review, by full commission, along with his form 32, requesting to waive the filing fee's. Due to his present incarceration without funds. The Chair Person rejected the Appellant's form 32 to waive the filing fee's without stating why. The Appellant later refquested to be allowed to file under the prison litigation act, but was never responded too. The Appellant now appeals to the South Carolina Court Of Appeals once again. After being dismissed from Appeal September 30, 2016 by Court of Appeals. On December 1st, 2016 Judge Lockemy issued an Order reinstating this appeal. Limiting the scope of the appeal to be soley on issues stemming from the denial of Appellant's request to waive filing fees, and dismissal of his appeal to the commission.

ARGUMENT

- (1). The Chair Person Erred by rejecting Appellant's form 32. Where a clerical error was made by the clerks office clocking form 30 in on March 11, 2016 insted of date it was mailed, March 8, 2016, with the accompanying certificate of service dated March 8, 2016. See: 23 S.C. Code Ann. Regs 67-205 (D) (1976) However several of the Appellant's forms including form 30 are deemed filed on the date of the accompanying certificate of service properly addressed to the commissioner.

- (2). The Clerks Office Erred where it clocked in Appellant's form 30 March 11, 2016, after the accompanying certificate of service revealed date mailed out March 8, 2016

Here the single commissioner served a copy of its order on February 24, 2016 (Single Commissioner Order, Pg 20 attached as exhibit(B). Appellant had fourteen days to request Commission review of the single commissioners order by filing form 30 by March 9, 2016. Appellant's handwritten certificate of service accompanying his form 30 is dated March 8, 2016. (Form 30) is attached as Exhibit C).

It appears the commission committed a clerical error by dating the form 30 as March 11, 2016, which was the date the Commission Clerks Office recieved it. The Commission Chair Person should have accepted Appellant's form 30 and grante to waive the filing fee's on form 32. Because the Appellants form 30 was timely. Therefor the Chair person Erred as well denying form 32 .

CONCLUSIONS

The Appellant prays the Court issues its Order reversing the decision denying Appellant his right to file Pro Se' waiving the filing fees by South Carolina Workers Compensation Commission Chair Person. as the Court deems just and proper.
