3. I am partially disabled and over 65 years old.
4. I reside within the City of Charleston, South Carolina at:

6. My Social Security Number is: 250-94-5691.
7. I am unmarried.
8. I do not have any dependents.
9. My sole financial (monetary) support is Supplemental Security Income (S.S.I.) in the amount of \$733.00 monthly by Credit Union deposit from the United States Social Security Administration.
10. Within the past twelve months, I have not received any money from any business, profession, self employment, rent payments, interests, dividends, pensions, annuities, life insurance payments, gifts, inheritances, or other sources.

- 11. I maintain a credit union account with less than \$100.00, for my S.S.I. deposits mentioned at line 9 above.
- 12. I do not own any real estate, stocks, bonds, notes, or other valuable property.
- 13. I do not own a motor vehicle.
- 14. I am a homemaker, and I pay \$550.00 monthly rent.
- 15. I pay all costs to maintain utilities, telephone, water, electricity (heat/cooling).
- 16. I pay for my travel via public transportation.
- 17. I pay for purchases of necessities (clothes, footwear, laundry and cleaners, haircuts, household supplies, hygiene supplies, stationery supplies and costs of mailings).
