

**RULE 203(d)(1)(B)(iv) EXPLANATION OF APPEAL**

Kadeem Neals (Appellant) appeals his guilty plea and sentence in the aforementioned cases. Appellant pled guilty on July 13, 2017, to Felony DUI with Death. The State sought a sentence of ten (10) years. The plea court accepted Appellant's guilty plea, and deferred sentencing for a pre-sentence report to be completed by the Department of Probation, Parole, and Pardon Services (DPPP). On October 16, 2017, Appellant was sentenced by the court to ten (10) years incarceration. Undersigned counsel is filing this appeal at the request of Appellant, and pursuant to State v. Thrift, 378 S.C. 70, 661 S.E.2d 373 (2008), Weathers v. White, 319 S.C. 59, 459 S.E.2d 838 (1995), and In-re Anonymous Member of the Bar, 303 S.C. 306, 400 S.E.2d 483 (1991). Although Counsel asserts this filing is timely pursuant to Rule 263, SCACR. (the tenth day fell on July 3, 2015—a State Holiday—and July 6, 2015 is the first available day thereafter to file), Counsel knows of no issue that can be reviewed on direct appeal.
