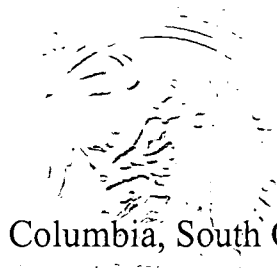

ORDER

This is an appeal from the Administrative Law Court's (ALC) order, which was received by Appellant on August 2, 2017. Appellant served the administrative law court with the notice of appeal on October 2, 2017. Because Appellant failed to timely serve the ALC, this appeal is dismissed. *See* Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR ("When a statute allows a decision of the administrative law court or agency (administrative tribunal) to be appealed directly to the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeals, the notice of appeal shall be served on the agency, the administrative law court (if it has been involved in the case) and all parties of record within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision."); Rule 263(b), SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act *except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rules 203 and 243* may be extended or shortened by the appellate court, or by any judge or justice thereof." (emphasis added)).
