ORDER

The parties have reported that they are negotiating a settlement to this appeal. The Court issued an order dismissing the appeal based on respondent's notification, and the appellant filed a motion to reinstate. To allow time for negotiation of the settlement, we will hold the remittitur until the parties notify the Court that settlement is finalized. However, absent a showing of good cause, if confirmation of settlement has not been provided to the Court within 90 days from the date of this order, the case will be remitted. If, prior to the expiration of 90 days, the parties notify the Court that they could not finalize the settlement, the Court will consider the appellant's motion to reinstate.
