Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of John Wayne Brannon v. State with the Supreme Court on September 29, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Claude E. Reed v. State with the Supreme Court on September 15, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




