## ORDER

---

This appeal is dismissed because the orders denying the motion for a change in venue, the motion to stay, and the motion to disqualify are not immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330 of the South Carolina Code (2017).<sup>1</sup> See *Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 339 S.C. 89, 529 S.E.2d 11 (2000) (providing an order granting or refusing a change in venue is not immediately appealable); *Townsend v. Townsend*, 323 S.C. 309, 474 S.E.2d 424 (1996) (providing the denial of a motion to disqualify a judge is not appealable until final judgment). The remitter will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
