
Pursuant to letter of this Court dated October 10, 2017, the Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Record on Appeal are due on October 9, 2017. The preparation of these documents has been complicated by the delay in receiving one of the two transcripts of hearings in this matter, but that transcript has now been received. Preparation of the Designation of Record has also been complicated as the SC Workers Compensation Commission did not forward its record in this case to the Circuit Court for hearing of the appeal. Although the Circuit Court did allow the supplementation of the record, the full record for the Commission was never forwarded to the Circuit Court and counsel for Appellate is having to determine if the current documents which are necessary to prepare the Record on Appeal have actually been filed with the Circuit Court.

Furthermore, counsel for Appellant has been out of the office for just over a week over the past month and has also been trying to prepare for the mediation of a significant pedestrian-truck personal injury action, resulting in a traumatic brain injury, which is currently scheduled for Friday, November 10, 2017.

For all of the above reasons counsel for Appellant would respectfully request an additional thirty days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Record.


