

Dear Mr. Shearouse:

Pursuant to Rule 243(b), SCACR, and this Court's order filed August 1, 2017, the transcript of the PCR court's proceeding in this matter is due to be ordered by today's date. As I explained in my previous letter dated July 28, 2017, I have not been hired to handle this appeal, and I am in the process of having Appellate Defense determine whether or not they will represent the Petitioner in this matter. I was previously contacted by Appellate Defense to obtain a supplemental affidavit of indigency from the Petitioner as the affidavit that she originally provided was incomplete. I sent the supplemental affidavit to her, which she returned to me. However, the supplemental affidavit that she returned to me was also incomplete. I consequently sent her a second supplemental affidavit and requested that she return it to me having answered all of the questions completely. I have not yet received the completed supplemental affidavit from her. Therefore, I respectfully request a second thirty-day extension of time to order the PCR hearing transcript. I expect that this extension will afford my client and me enough time to transfer representation to Appellate Defense. There has been one previous extension request in this matter.
