I am copying all counsel, who have been consulted prior to this email and consent to this request.

Thank you for taking my call this morning. I am writing to request that you communicate with the deputy clerk regarding the response date for Respondents' final brief. Mr. Greeley previously submitted a motion in coordination with my office, on October 24 requesting thirty (30) days.
