

ORDER

Appellant's request to stay the writ of ejectment is denied at this time because Appellant has failed to show that he first made the motion to the circuit court or that he has complied with the undertaking requirement set forth in section 27-40-800 of the South Carolina Code (2007). *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 27-40-800 (2007) (providing that a writ of ejectment shall be stayed on appeal if the appellant signs an undertaking that he will pay the landlord the amount of rent determined by the circuit court and if the appellant complies with the terms of the undertaking).
