## Urgent Necessary Investigation

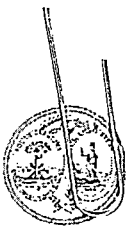

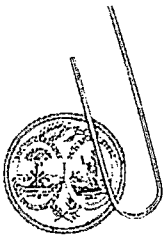
