Upon reviewing your "Appendix to the Record on Appeal," the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, each page of the document contains 2 page numbers, and are not legible. The pages must be numbered in consecutive order, and must be legible.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. It must read pursuant to the Court's letter dated August 23, 2017. A copy of this letter is included for your reference.
- The Index is not in compliance with Rule 210, SCACR. Specifically, the index only lists page 1 as being included in the document.
- The proof of service indicates you served the respondent on October 23, 2017 for appellate case number 2015-2505.
- An amended supplemental record on appeal must be served and filed which corrects all of the above deficiencies.


