COMES NOW the Respondent Yuasa Exide, Inc., by and through its undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and moves this Honorable Court for a second extension of thirty (30) days' time to serve and file its initial brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

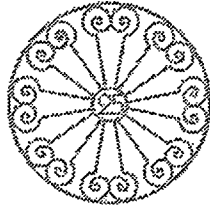

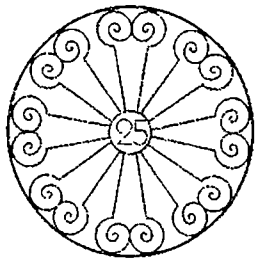
