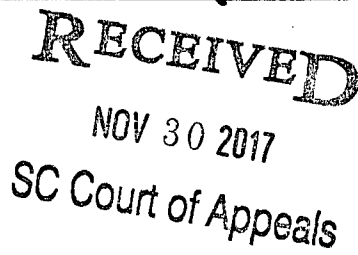
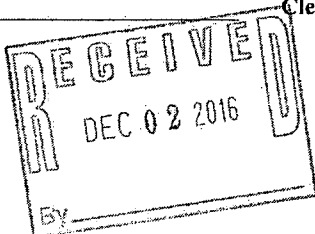

Plaintiff moves for entry of a default judgment against defendants Stephen Bretzinger and Lindsey Holsinger. It appears that the defendants Bretzinger and Holsinger were served with the summons and complaint in this matter via publication in the Sun Sentinel on September 22, 2016,, September 29, 2016 and lastly on October 06, 2016 (see Affidavit of Publication filed by the Clerk of Court in this matter on October 14, 2016). No responsive pleadings were filed and an Affidavit of Default was submitted with a Motion for Default Judgment and a proposed Order of Judgment on November 8, 2016.
