Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I am in receipt of opposing counsel's letter dated November 30<sup>th</sup> responding to Claire Allen's letter of November 29<sup>th</sup>. If I can find the time, I will probably be filing another Motion to Dismiss in addition to the Court's deficiency letter. After review, I see nothing in the letter in reference to clarification as to the discrepancies that could not have been handled by a simple phone call to the Court and a review of the Court's letter and the Rules of the Court.

In reality, the letter seeks an unlimited extension of time again and seeks to place responsibility for clarification back on the Court thus delaying the filing of the Record until after the Court gives that clarification and then after that ask for an additional 10 days from that date to file. While I have begged the Court for forgiveness for myself in the past, to my knowledge I have never sought to place the burden back on the Court and asked for an unlimited amount of time to comply with the Rules of the Court; with which it is our responsibility to read and comply. If Counsel wants an extension, he should have filed a Motion for that purpose to which I could have responded.

While I cannot think of a situation where I would ask for an unlimited extension of time and to place compliance with the Rules back on the Court and while again I fully intend, if I can find the time, to file another Motion to Dismiss based on the multiple delinquencies and delays in processing the Appeal, I see no reason for the Court to grant any extension in this matter.


