

**ORDER DENYING MOTIONS FOR
RECONSIDERATION**

This matter is before the Administrative Law Court ("Court") pursuant to the motion filed September 29, 2017, by Wayne's Automotive Center, Inc. ("Petitioner") seeking reconsideration of the Court's Final Order that was filed on September 19, 2017, and the reconsideration motion of the South Carolina Department of Public Safety ("Respondent") filed October 2, 2017. Petitioner and Respondent filed responses in opposition to the other party's motion on October 11, 2017. The arguments in both Petitioner's and Respondent's motion and reply reiterate the arguments made during the hearing, held July 31, 2017. These arguments, along with the evidence and testimony presented, have been carefully considered and ruled upon by this Court. As far as the motions and/or replies raise new issues and arguments, the Court will not consider improperly raised arguments that should have been brought before this Court prior to the issuance of the Final Order. The motions and replies do not seek to present newly discovered evidence, and the Court perceives no manifest errors of law or fact in its Final Order.

Therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that both Petitioner's Motion to Reconsider and Respondent's Motion to Reconsider are **DENIED**.
