ORDER

Appellant has appealed the circuit court's orders certifying a class, finding the Plaintiffs have standing to represent the class, and denying reconsideration. After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss is granted because the underlying orders on appeal are not immediately appealable. *See Schein v. Lamar*, 274 S.C. 329, 263 S.E.2d 383 (1980); *Knowles v. Standard Savings and Loan Assoc.*, 274 S.C. 58, 261 S.E.2d 49 (1979) (finding class certification orders are not immediately appealable).
