## ORDER

Wayne's Automotive Center, Inc. (Wayne's Automotive) has filed a motion requesting this court to issue a supersedeas to stay matters decided in the Administrative Law Court's orders. This court temporarily grants the stay for twenty days from the date of this order for the purpose of allowing Wayne's Automotive to petition for relief with the Administrative Law Court. *See* Rule 241(d)(1), SCACR ("Except where extraordinary circumstances make it impracticable, an application for an order lifting the automatic stay or for supersedeas must first be made to the lower court or administrative tribunal which entered the order or decision on appeal."). The Administrative Law Court has jurisdiction to consider this petition for supersedes pursuant to Rule 241 while this appeal is pending. Nothing in this order prevents the parties from filing a request for this court to continue the stay upon the expiration of twenty days if the Administrative Law Court has not yet ruled on the petition.
