
ORDER

Pursuant to *Dennison v. State*, 371 S.C. 221, 639 S.E.2d 35 (2006), petitioner's counsel has advised this Court that he cannot provide a good faith explanation under Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). By order dated October 24, 2017, this Court gave petitioner twenty days to file a *pro se* explanation under Rule 243(c), SCACR. Petitioner has not filed a *pro se* explanation.

Accordingly, based on the failure of the petitioner to provide the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, the notice of appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
