MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Robert A. Young respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until January 8, 2017**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
 2. Counsel for Robert A. Young respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Kevin Ward with the Court of Appeals on November 3, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and the petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State along with the accompanying appendix in the case of Dennis Wright v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 24, 2017. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Eric Spears with the Supreme Court on October 19, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Demario Monte Thompson with the Supreme Court on October 17, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Umar Abdul Clea v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 12, 2017. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Johnny Neal Sexton, II with the Court of Appeals on October 4, 2017.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.




