


At a Court of General Sessions, convened on the 18th day of August, 2017, the Grand Jurors of Laurens County present upon their oath:

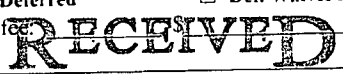


