I'm writing you today because I'm concerned about how can my case still be in remittitur since September 28, 2015 was there a judgement or ruling that was handed down from the lower court or tribunal that I wasn't aware of? Exactly how can the state skip over their own process? because the Attorney General's office in their return not only granted a full evidentiary hearing they requested one and in Jan 2016 I received a letter from assistant public defender McMillen along with another filled out PCR application he completed stating that he didn't file my direct appeal in a timely manner and with the correct parties and that the state was going to grant me a belated appeal and then my PCR lawyer sent me a letter in March 2016 saying she was no longer representing me and she kept the

PCR Application he'd sent me admitting he was ineffective as my trial counsel in which he really was the worst inexperienced ever in the history of South Carolina and then Judge early didn't sign the order until August 2016 and I didn't get an appellate defender until November 15 2016 and it had been pending in the Supreme Court for 16 months and then on Nov. 2 2017 I received a letter from SUSAN B Hackett telling me that my case had been transferred to the Court of Appeals pursuant to Rule 2430) SCAC a panel of 3 Judges (when & How) can this be done when it's already in remittitur? This can't be legal and in fact I should have been released from prison there is no legal purpose for me to be held unlawfully if so please tell me why I should be doing time... Recently here on Perry's yard Nov. 19 I was stabbed 5 times and I nearly died from the wounds all for another

inmate overheard the C/O tell me
to pack my things because I was
beings moved right then and he
followed me into my room and started
stabbing me and trying to kill me
for no reason.... Here's my deal
on this entire situation first of
all I'm very actually innocent I
didn't do any crime I'm a father of
5 kids 3 grandkids and I've got
a life and a career as a truck
driver and my aging father and
mother and I don't want to be
killed or hurt in prison especially
when I shouldn't be here... I'm
relieving Ms. Hackett as my counsel
because she was not defending
me at all just making excuses
for the state when anybody
who can read can plainly see
that I'm innocent and I most
certainly shouldn't be in prison
Please respond Thank you
