



ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 222 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the motion for costs filed by Respondent is granted in the amount of \$1,098.60 against Appellant. See Rule 222(a), SCACR (providing that costs shall be taxed against the Appellant when the appeal is dismissed or judgment on appeal is affirmed); Rule 222(b), SCACR (permitting a party to recover costs for printing the party's final brief, in addition to attorney's fees of up to \$1,000). The lower court or tribunal is directed to add this award of costs to the remittitur.
