I being duly sworn depose and swear to the following:

I am an inmate at the Lieber Correctional Institution and at this facility I am being denied access to meet my court-deadline by not being allowed to the Law Library and/or Mailroom.

I have informed the Respondents, Christopher D. Florian on several occasions regarding Lieber Correctional Institution excessive lock-downs, which directly affecting the efficacy of my ability to comply with the strict requirements of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) with regard to correcting the deficiencies in the above-reference case within the allotted ten (10) days of the date of noticed which was November 8, 2012.

I am informing again the Respondents and NOW the Courts that Lieber Correctional Institution has my housing unit on lock-down beginning on the early morning of November 9th, 2012 upon me being in receipt of the courts notice and I have flat-out been denied my constitutionality right to grieve the Courts and use the U.S. mailroom at Lieber. My housing unit is presently still on lock-down beyond my control and not any of my wrong doings as of this Court being in receipt of this affidavit and motion.

I had to re-open my legal envelop to enclosed this affidavit to show this Honorable Court my due diligence in being in compliance with South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) and I have spoken specifically with these employees of Respondents regarding the aforementioned matter. Johnson (A1) and Mr. Snider (A1) upon whom feeding throughout this matter, but to no avail of any assistance or compelling of them to there very own mandated Policy GA. O.G.
