
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I just received notice from Ms. Kenya Miller, Attorney at Law, who is representing the Defendants, and Appellants in the above-referenced Appeal, that her clients have decided to voluntarily comply with the provisions of §42-17-60; are forwarding us payment; and are in the process of notifying the doctors for the provision of medical care. Based on this, I would appreciate it if the Court would issue a brief Order simply confirming that the Defendants are voluntarily complying and making payment pursuant to §42-17-60 and on that basis, dismiss our motion but I would request that it be without prejudice until such time as we can confirm that everything is in place.
