MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Damon T. Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. 4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




