Dear Clerk;

The record before this Honorable Court indicates that Appellate counsel has taken several extensions prior to filing its initial Anders Brief. The Court then alerted Appellant, giving him forth-five (45) days to include his pro-se appellant brief. The date the Court forwarded this notice was dated November 15, 2017.

Here, Appellant is humbly and respectfully requesting "just a single extension for a couple of reasons". First of which, I received the notice much later than the normal time. And such has taken away some of the time the Court extended. Second, do to shortness of staff, Appellant cannot frequent the law library as needed. Coupled with random "acts of violence" which caused the entire prison to be kept in their respective cells.

Finally, with the Christmas Holidays stretching across the given dates, such also takes away from the time to prepare the brief, as the Dept. of Corrections observes this Holiday, and will be even shorter with staff personnel.

Again, this is not an attempt to delay the Court, but instead a bonifide request (an only one) for an extension of time for the reasons outlined above. Thank you in advance.

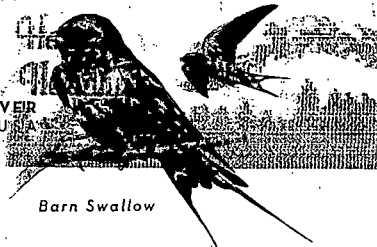
