



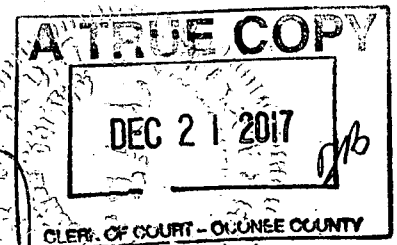

1. The Defendant entered a guilty plea to the above-referenced indictment and was sentenced by the Honorable Judge C. Maddox on October 30, 2017.
2. At the time of the plea a restitution hearing was held in abeyance and heard on December 11, 2017. At the restitution hearing the Defendant was represented by Public Defender Suzanne Earle and the State of South Carolina was represented by Assistant Solicitor Bethany Blundy. The State and the Defendant stipulated to the amount of outstanding medical bills incurred by the victim, David Seth Pearce.
3. After considering oral arguments it is so ordered that the Defendant pay to the victim, David Seth Pearce, the amount of \$3,069.80. At the time of the entry of this order the victim has submitted a SOVA application for reimbursement, but has not yet received a response. If SOVA should accept responsibility and pay some or all of the victim's medical bills, then the Defendant shall reimburse SOVA.
