

Dear Mr. Alston:

Upon reviewing your motion dated December 18, 2017, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide a proof of service for your motion, not the notice of appeal. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document is not legible. Specifically, bottoms of the copied pages are omitted. The document will need to be resubmitted in a format that is legible and complies with the requirements of Rule 267, SCACR.
