ORDER

The motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Appellant filed a motion for "prisoner pro se status," which this court construes as a motion to relax Rules 210, 211, and 267 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. This request is granted. Appellant must still serve Respondent as required by the rules, but he is permitted to file only one copy of his initial brief, reply brief (if any), final brief(s), and record on appeal with this court. Moreover, Appellant must provide a cover page to the record and his brief(s). The covers may be of any material and in any color, and must contain only the caption.
