PERSONALLY REQUESTING THAT Deborah Harwell says:

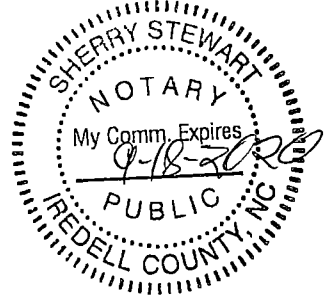
1. I am over the age of eighteen (18), competent to give this affidavit on my own personal knowledge.

Dear Judge Kitchings:


Enclosed is a copy of the Emergency Motion for Continuance and supporting Affidavit filed with the Court of Appeals, mailed to other associated attorneys.
