


## ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to provide the notice of appeal filing fee, the order on appeal, and proof of timely service of the notice of appeal on Respondent and the Administrative Law Court. Appellant has now filed a petition to reinstate. Appellant's proof of service of the notice of appeal indicates Appellant did not timely serve the Administrative Law Court with the notice of appeal. *See* Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR ("[T]he notice of appeal shall be served on . . . the administrative law court . . . and all parties of record within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision."). Accordingly, the petition to reinstate is denied.
