Please take Notice that the Appellant named above, by and through his undersigned Attorney, hereby files this Consent Order Granting Appellant Extension of Time to File Reply Brief and/or Record on Appeal.

The basis for this motion is that Initial Brief of Respondent was served upon the office for Appellant's counsel on November 7, 2017. Than the Appellant is granted an extension of time to file and serve his Reply Brief and Record on Appeal until January 2, 2018.




