

On November 30, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Elidoro Carrillo Ontivero with this Court. On November 20, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. James John Abernathy with this Court. On November 15, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Calvin Solomon Barr with this Court.


4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


