Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, as a non-attorney, you may represent only yourself in this Court. You must file an amended notice of appeal which includes the correct caption:

Churchill Park, Respondent,

v.

Alan G. Nix, Norma J. Nix and the Estate of Norma J. Nix, Defendants,

of which Alan G. Nix is the Appellant.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal referenced on your caption as case number 2014-CP-050407.
- You refer in your appeal to an order dated November 9, 2017. The only order provided was signed by the judge on December 1, 2017. You must provide a copy of any order you are appealing, and correctly refer to it on your amended notice of appeal.
- You must provide information regarding all motions still pending in these cases in the lower court.
