
Dear Mr. Kreis:

After review of your notice of appeal and other filings, in which you have provided multiple names and case numbers, the Court must clarify that the civil action case number currently on appeal in this Court is 2017-CP-28-00131, and the following deficiencies must be corrected within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed.

- You must file an amended notice of appeal that complies with Rule 203, SCACR, and includes all of the following information:
 1. The docket number of the case in the lower court.
 2. The name of the court.
 3. The judge.
 4. The county from which the appeal is taken.
 5. The date of the order from which the appeal is taken.
 6. The names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
- A proof of service for the notice of appeal that has been timely served on all respondents.

- A statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order(s) on appeal.
- Proof that you have served the notice of appeal with the lower court clerk of court.
- The Court construes your September 28, 2017, filing, as a request to proceed in forma pauperis. Within fifteen (15) days you must file a motion to proceed in forma pauperis that complies with Rule 240 and 267, SCACR, along with a proof of service on all respondents, or the Court will not consider your request.
- You must provide proof that you have timely ordered the transcript directly from the court reporter, pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR.
