
Dear Ms. Brailsford:

Upon reviewing your "brief of appellant," which the Court has construed as a second attempted record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion for an extension of time and to file out of time will not be considered and this appeal will be dismissed. The deficiencies listed relate only to the format of the record on appeal. The deficiencies are as follows:

- The cover of the record on appeal should contain a complete caption in substantially the same form as that of Form 15 in Part II, Appendix C, SCACR.
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages of the record on appeal are not consecutively numbered, starting from the index through the end of the document.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the document is incorrectly titled, "Brief of Appellant," when it should be titled, "Record on Appeal."

- The document is accompanied by a certificate of counsel, however, the certificate incorrectly states it is the final brief. You must provide a certificate of counsel for the record on appeal.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The index, required by Rule 210, SCACR, must match with the page numbers throughout the record on appeal.
- You must serve and file an amended record on appeal, fixing all of the deficiencies listed above, within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
