



ORDER


The South Carolina Court of Appeals issued an opinion dismissing this appeal after conducting a review pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 S.C. 738 (1967).¹ By order dated October 16, 2017, this Court denied petitioner's request for an extension to file a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the opinion of the Court of Appeals. This denial was based on the fact that this Court has held that it "will no longer entertain petitions for a writ of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has dismissed an appeal after conducting an *Anders* review." *State v. Lyles*, 381 S.C. 442, 673 S.E.2d 811 (2009).

Petitioner has now filed a motion to alter or amend, and this motion has been construed as a petition for rehearing. The petition is denied.
