I am request that our case be re-instated based on my mis-reading of rule 207. My focus was on the request and the cost and I failed to not "make arrangements for payment". In saying this I had no intentions of delaying payment as required by Ms Scott. I was trying to remember how to reduce the cost and then I had a stroke. The letter as stated by Ms t Kitchens indicated a date of September 9, 2017. I had a stroke on October 24<sup>th</sup> and was seen in emergency (ER) on the 25<sup>th</sup>. I thought the stroke was mild and I was lucky because I did not go to ER on the 24<sup>th</sup>. I have been struggling cognitively and physically with the aftermath of the stroke as my brain tries to reroute muscle and cognitive memory. Malcolm as co appellant has had some significant health issues and loss of work based on a false accusation where he could not even draw unemployment. I directed him to EEOC and cannot get into any details regarding that process. He has sickle cell anemia and can provide medical documentation of how that stress affected him. I talked to Ms Allen about my request and as I looked further into rule 607 it provided me with a method of getting transcripts at a less cost using (F) of rule 607. I sent her emails indicating this method. I will include the emails I sent to Ms Scott using the email address provided to me by Ms Allen. All attorneys in this matter will be sent the information, motion and

emails. I will note by email and hard copy that I can send a money order to her/ Ms Scott on January 2, 2017 if it pleases her and the court.

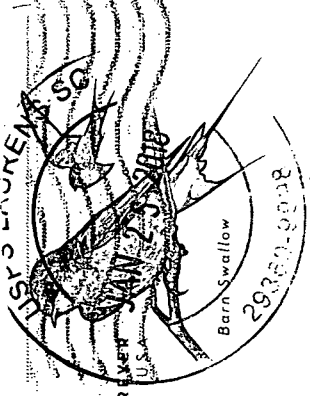

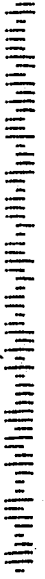

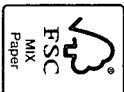
