MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Gregory Fitzgerald Young respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Gregory Fitzgerald Young respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Chief Appellate Defender Robert M. Dudek wishes to review all of counsel's pleadings for counsel's first six to twelve months with the Division of Appellate Defense, but is presently out of the office with Influenza A and thus unable to review counsel's petition for writ of certiorari. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gregory Daniel Price v. State with the Supreme Court on January 16, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. James Anthony Haynes with the Court of Appeal on December 4, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Casey Stuckey v. State with the Supreme Court on December 1, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Michael Taquarius Rencher with the Court of Appeals on November 6, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




