MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel for J'Corey Suave Hull-Kilgore respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

Counsel filed the Motion to Dismiss the Notice of Appeal as Interlocutory in State v. Ronald Hakeem Mack with the Court of Appeals on December 19, 2017. Counsel appeared in general session's court in Richland County for a hearing in State v. Michael A. Smith on December 7, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


