Dear Counsel:

Upon further review of your motion to substitute counsel and the accompanying proof of service, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:

- The motion to substitute counsel and the accompanying proof of service are not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The case caption must read as follows:

Federal National Mortgage Association, Respondent,

v.

John D. Dalen, Julie A. Dalen and Wawtockace Hills Property Owners Association, Defendants,

Of whom John D. Dalen and Julie A. Dalen are Appellants,

And

John D. Dalen and Julie A. Dalen, Appellants,

v.

Bank of America, N.A., successor by merger to BAC Home Loans Servicing, L.P. f/k/a Countrywide Home Loans Servicing, L.P., Respondent.

- The language contained in the motion is incorrect. The parties to the appeal must be referred to as “respondent” or “appellants”.
- The language contained in the proof of service is incorrect. The caption states it is in federal court, not state court. You must also correctly name the motion that was served. The proof of service states that the “PETITION TO SUBSTITUTE PLAINTIFF” was served.
- You must file an amended motion and proof of service.
