
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

The appeal of the above-referenced matter is being held in abeyance pursuant to the Court's letter dated April 16, 2012 pending the final resolution of the appeal in the CarMax Auto Super Stores West Coast, Inc. v. South Carolina Department of Revenue (Appeal from the Administrative Law Court Case No. 09-ALJ-17-0160-CC) (the "CarMax Appeal"). In compliance with the Court's instructions requesting status updates every 60 days, we summarize below the status of the CarMax Appeal.

We continue to await the Court's ruling on the Petitions for Writ of Certiorari filed by both parties. As reported in our previous letters, both parties filed Petitions for Writ of Certiorari to the South Carolina Supreme Court on June 6, 2012, with each party filing their returns to the petitions on July 6, 2012 and their replies to the returns July 16, 2012.
