

MOTION FOR EXTENSION

The Petitioner filed his Notice of Appeal (Writ of Certiorari) on May 30, 2017. Respondent subsequently filed a Motion to Supplement Appendix in this case. Through inadvertence, Petitioner was not aware of this motion and learned of the motion upon the Court's Order issued January 17, 2018, compelling Petitioner to supplement the Appendix.

The Court's January 17th Order states that Petitioner has twenty (20) days from the date of the Order to supplement the Appendix. Petitioner has compiled most of the requested documents to supplement the Appendix, however, Petitioner does not possess the transcripts (from the February 4, 2016 hearing and the August 4, 2016 hearing). The transcripts are the only materials which Petitioner is missing. Petitioner has ordered a copy of each transcript from the court reporters, but will need additional time to receive the transcripts from the court reporters.

Counsel for Petitioner has conferred with Counsel for Respondent, who has indicated they consent to this request for an extension of time to receive the transcripts.



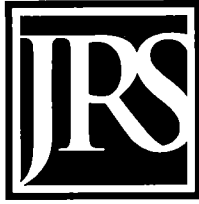
