



ORDER


This case was remitted on September 28, 2012. Respondent has filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking to recover \$76.11 for the cost of printing and copying the final brief, \$277.15 for the cost of the transcripts, and \$1,000 in attorney's fees, for a total of \$1,353.26. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion. After careful consideration, the motion for costs is granted. *See* Rule 222(a), SCACR (providing costs shall be taxed against the appellant when the judgment on appeal is affirmed); Rule 222(b) (providing the party entitled to recover costs may recover the cost of the court reporter's transcript, the cost of printing the party's final brief, and attorney's fees in the amount of \$1,000).
